Guide to applying for Stellae Matutinae - "Stars of tomorrow"

Applicants must be born after 1 January 1999. In addition, the following must be uploaded:

- 1. two high-resolution photos
- 2. a short curriculum vitae with details of musical education, participation in master classes and/or competitions and selected projects
- 3. a detailed programme containing the NAMES AND DATES OF LIFE of the composer and the TITLES of the works (name, opus, number and/or tonality)
- 4. two videos via links (YouTube or similar) with pieces that are part of the program.

Ideally, **the photos** should be high-contrast, colourful, in JPEG format and in the range of 4000x6000 pixels upwards. One of them should be in portrait format, the other in landscape format. The photos can show applicants at the instrument or alone. Passport photos or yearbook photos are not sufficient.

Examples:





CVs must be written in continuous text. The names and titles of teachers or musical partners must be correctly indicated and contain the correct umlauts (e.g. Prof. Jana Boušková). The same applies to institutions, information on competitions won or masterclasses completed.

It is possible to start with a hook: "Winner of competition xy, winner of scholarship xy". You can also start with an excerpt from a newspaper review or an assessment of a teacher. Afterwards, the training and career can be continued chronologically.

An example of the structure of the CV:

Introduction "with rushing harp sounds, xyz thrilled the audience" – musikalische

Zeitung, January 2024

First experiences xyz receives his first harp lessons at the age of five at the (music school)

with (teacher). Just two years later, the first prizes at youth music

competitions followed.

Current status xyz is currently receiving lessons from (professor). He also attends master

classes with (person 1, 2 and 3). As a member of the (youth orchestra) and the (chamber music group) he has already performed at the (music

festival).

Personal is passionately interested in (baroque music), composes and writes

poems. In her free time, she likes to go on long hikes and help out at the

(local animal shelter).

Programs must also contain the correct information and umlauts for names. Here is an example:

Videos can be submitted as a link from all common platforms.

Technical requirements:

Recording devices: Cameras, camcorders, smartphones

Image detail: Landscape format

Camera should be set up frontally if possible

If possible, position the camera at about head height

Instrument and applicant must be fully visible

Face and hands must be clearly visible

Image quality: Illuminate the room and the applicant well

Don't use the selfie camera on mobile devices

Sound: Use of an external microphone is recommended

Audio track must be synchronized with video Separate audio tracks cannot be considered

The videos must not be compressed, edited, or cut.

Please save and upload each played work as a single video.

Recommendations: Place the external microphone no more than 3 meters away from the

instrument

A strong light source behind the musician should be avoided Recording room should be neither over-acoustic nor too dry

Record in daylight if possible
